on 2. J.

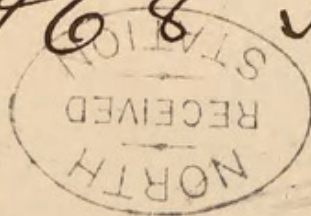
