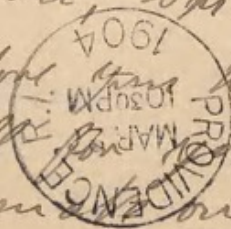


Forw'd 3 is about ready.

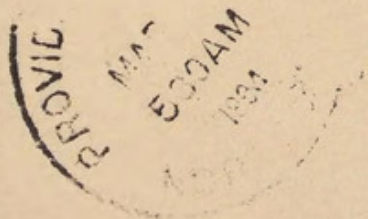
