except in the autumn when you are away.

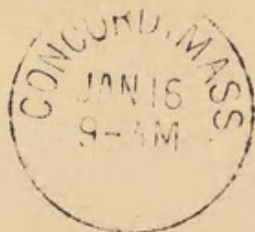
