The year that has elapsed since
the Dover meeting of this Society,
has been one of considerable activity
~~for this committee~~ to the Bryo. Comm.

More than half ^{of the members} of this committee have
been ~~actively~~ engaged, for at least
a portion of their available time, in
determining Maine Bryophytes (mosses,
mosses) while all have done
more or less collecting.

Several species ~~new to the state~~
~~of mosses~~ have been added to
the ^{state} list ~~as new for the state~~
although just at present I am
unable to state the exact number.

Since the Dover meeting, ^{more than 150 specimens of the} mosses or
hepatics ^{collected} have been forwarded to me,
^{having been} coll. at various places ~~in Maine~~, such as
Kineo, Hebron, Dover, Foxcroft, Searsville
Otisfield, Bristol, Danverscotta, Brunswick
Washam, Leland & Ellsworth,

Most of these have ~~been~~ already been
determined.

My own collections in No. in 1897 comprise
129 numbers from Dover, Foxcroft, Saugerville
Kinross, Oakland, Carratunk, Concord,
Pleasant Ridge, Embden, N. Anson, & Bingham.
These are ~~mostly~~ almost wholly undetermined
at the present time.

The greater portion ^{of these} were collected by Mrs.
Stevens, Miss Clarke and Mr. Chamberlain, of
this committee, and Miss Gurlink &
Mr. Fernald.
