Dear Dr

As I wrote in my
last I have put up a
few little orchids & a bit
of two trees which I
mean to send as far as
New York by your name-
sake Mr. Gray I don't
know when he will go
but probably before long
— by the first good ship
The orchids are in dupli-
cate. You can send one or
both to Lindley. But as

you may observe one is
marked as scanty & of an-
other I send all I have
yet seen. I am still
dilly-dallying as you see
but not willingly. There
^{is} not much to be found
now in botany. I think
I shall go to Mount Auburn
in a few days after I
shall have collected a few
more birds. I am becom-
ing very anxious to hear
from you again.

I am sorry now you did
not take the responsibility

of sending me money in
the same way you did at
first. I thought it would
be best to remit through
Mr Allen but I did not
anticipate so much
