Dear Dr

(Yesterday started for St. Sophie  
Cuba Bayano & expecting to get  
money in Saltadero or Cala. Today  
returned here in chase of that valueless  
certificate. Tell Loring the next time  
he indorses away any thing of the kind  
not to leave his signature in the  
inkstand.

I call to mind a jocular remark  
you once made "You'll be the death  
of me yet" on the occasion of <sup>some</sup> awkward-  
ness of mine or unsystematical way  
of doing things. I think now I have  
full right to retort on you or your agent,  
"Well I must set about to borrow money  
better than wait here two months in  
idleness. I think I'll succeed. But I shall  
see you a few days time."

I am resolved to keep you reminded of  
some things I want to know - as the  
"4 big Dictionaries": "Darwin" & "critique"  
"How high do the numbers of the collection  
(the present one) run?" Try to find out if I  
am likely ever to realize any thing for my  
mosses & Lichens or whether they will

be part of the inheritance of my heirs. I sent  
you the leaves & a bit of wood of a large kind  
enveloped in a small leaf. It was indigenous  
or exotic. Perhaps that letter was lost. I am  
confidus some have been or are gone to London.
