given on the Port au Port labels.

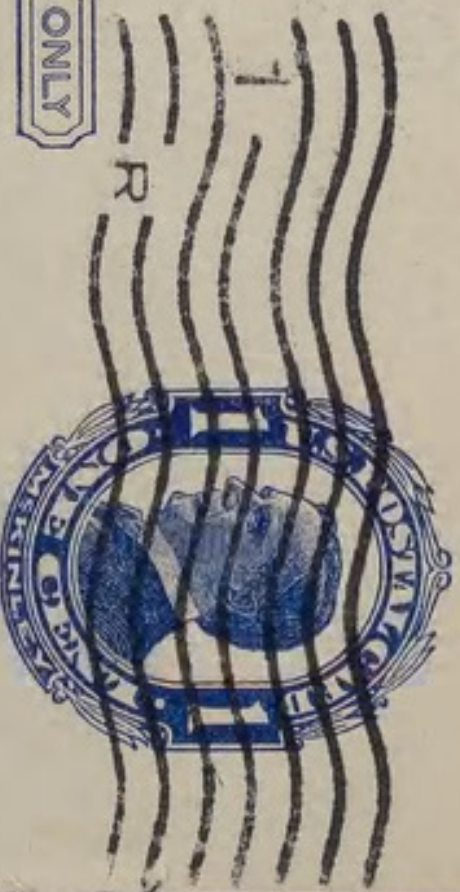
I presume the latter is the one
