We have just received
from Mr. Char. J. Lyon of the faculty
of Dartmouth College a cultivated
specimen of *Pleurothallis* *Brig-*
hamii S. Wats., which was collected
on Barro Colorado Island as an
epiphyte on a rotten fallen log
in January 1931. This species ap-
pears to be unrecorded from that
locality.
