

Quebec. June 19th/72.

My dear Dr. Kennedy,

Your most kind & cordial
letter of the 12th Inst. I received in Montreal
2 days ago & only delayed replying to it
till we could arrange our plans from
here. We have been disappointed in getting
on to the Saguenay as the steamers do
not begin to run till next week. so would
it suit you equally well for us to visit
you now instead of postponing it till the
end of our tour which we may be too
hurried. We hope to get to Saratoga on
Tuesday next, & if agreeable to you would
come on to Northampton on the Thursday &
stay till the Saturday on which day we
are due in Boston. A line from you to
the Post office Saratoga will find us if
you would kindly say, if this offer of ours
is quite agreeable & convenient. As
you are with a friend & we have arranged
a different time to the one you did, it may

probably not be convenient to receive us
under your roof & we ~~can~~ shall
be quite willing "to abide in an hostelry."

We have had a very pleasant trip with
only few drawbacks & fine weather. We
did not go further west than Chicago
& returned not soon for the Sagamore but
will make it up by visiting the White-
Mountain's more in detail. This is a
charming old town. I have always prided
myself on antiquity, & the towns are
splendid. We only arrived this morning &
have tomorrow to have but much time left
in all. but beyond the town itself there is
not much to see. I shall insure all
news till we meet & with reiterated thanks
for your kind remembrance of us & kind
invitation. Believe me with united
