I do in return? Shall I send you one of mine that I have had taken
recently? - I shall be glad to do so. And this reminds me to ask again
for the name and address of the photographer in the White Mts - who made the
beautiful transparency of Simoda that you sent in your study. I should
so like to get a lantern slide of it! And how is Biscutaria this year?
My last year's crop failed - although it started on my stump with 40 plants
they froze in January - This year I have 3 in the same old stump. I
think they are true saprophytes - & need decaying wood as Tetraphis does

In fact most mosses like mod. - brown - Sphagnum even is no exception -
though it takes its food much diluted - I have tried to get some
fresh Bombacina from Dedham - and have always regretted that we did not plant
graph these lovely specimens you sent me long ago! Do you remember how fine
they were? - I have never been in the deep woods in the snow - snow-
driving must be fascinating. I hope Mrs. Kennedy is well - What are
your plans for the summer? We shall probably be here as usual - until
"day-fewer" time and then perhaps get off to the mountains. I hope
before the paroxysms begin. Last year we stayed 2 or 3 days too late & Mr. Britton
was very miserable - when we did get away. Besides it was dreadfully hot - about
the 17th of August. The birds nest in June so there was no meeting up to. This year
it nests in October. With kindest regards from
