On page 622 there are <sup>(at least)</sup> 3 typo. errors which I detected in looking up this matter. On line 7 "codonopypis" should be "codonopypis", and on line 8 the first and last words should be "coelo-phyllum" instead of "calo-phyllum"

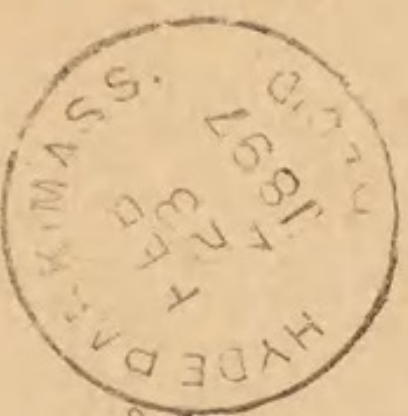
Am very glad you mentioned the subject as I think a great deal is learned in an interchange of ideas. I do not think that the mosses have yet been studied or collected sufficiently for us to know all the localities by any means, even as late as 1897, to say nothing of 1884 (L. + J. Mann) Anacamptodon occurs on Platanus and maple(?) in Va. (See Mem. Torr. Bot. Club. 4:186)
