I have tried to determine a couple of *Dicrana* within two days and as a result have decided that I do not know much about the genus and probably never have. If you had asked me a week ago I probably would have suggested *scoparium* or *majus* but today I feel more like saying any *Dicranum* from *fulvellum* to *elongatum* might be the one you are looking for.

Have been up to Harvard 5 days the past week and expect to be there nearly every day (except Christmas) the coming week. Have completed the rehauling of Bryum and find only a single small envelope of *B. alpinum*, that is
