named the 30 species of Texan
Grasses I sent him and sent
me 50 species of U.S. Grasses.
A valuable addition. I have
got the plants poisoned Sat.
in the mounting box, and have
spent the rest of the time
binding my thin pamphlets into
covers. I have sorted and laid
away those letters Ward gave
me. Excuse mine it is late.
I send you my picture for
inspection. Ever you W. Deane,
