I mailed the letter all right in the New York box.

Hello, Hello! I got home all right. My dear Dr. Kennedy, at 10.40 P.m. A half hour was expended in getting from Harv. Sq. to my house. The rain partially held up, and I might have just as well have taken my press home, and spared you any trouble. If it would be any more convenient to you to take it to Roxbury and send it over to me by messenger at my expense, I can take it out all right. Of course I am not really in the slightest hurry about it. Yesterday was the 13th not the 12th as I told you. What a good time we had. I took lots of things, almost all fruits. I don't think many collect fruits of *Cotus. Solidago* &c. I like it.

What a good time we had. How I
enjoyed your photos. It was a great
treat to me. It took me ever so long
to-day to fix my plates and my diary.
I studied that Lemna as far as we
can without influence. The fund
is exactly *Valdiviana* according to
description, elliptical-blond, somewhat
falcate, one rootlet to a fund. It cer-
tainly is nothing else in the Manual
I have *Spirodela*, and all our Lem-
nas but *Valdiviana* & *gibba*. It is
certainly not the latter with its 5
nerves and almost hemispherical
fund. I think Robinson is right unless
it is something out of the book.
I have already floated off on 6
small white sheets. 50 of them.
I want them for friends. Mrs.
Deane was very much pleased
with the *Camus* and the *Lovage*
Root. It was very kind of Mrs. Deane
I have taken to Dr. Robinson two small
bottles of the Lemna, fresh, from the two
localities so that he can study it
fresh. I trust Mr. Faxon did not get
cold with his wet feet & rheumatism
and general welling. J. R. C. is prof.
