

OCT 21. 1905. Dear Prof Hatzinger: I am just
home from the Eclipse of the sun at
Burgos in Spain and find your parcel
No 7 of Acrocarpi with postal & charges
\$1.50. I take pleasure in sending you
that amt, & trust my delay has not
troubled you: I went abroad on July
22^d & got a look at Holland Paris &
a Cook's Tourist party to Burgos where we
had a fine view of the Eclipse which how-
ever did not quite equal the Virginia
one of May 1900. As I travelled with 3
ladies I did not do much moss work,
in fact none. We had brilliant & dry
weather whi perhaps lessened the chance
of finding any. I have not yet opened
your Fascicle but anticipate much
pleasure in examining it with my kin-
dest regards believe me very truly yrs
