Dear Sir.

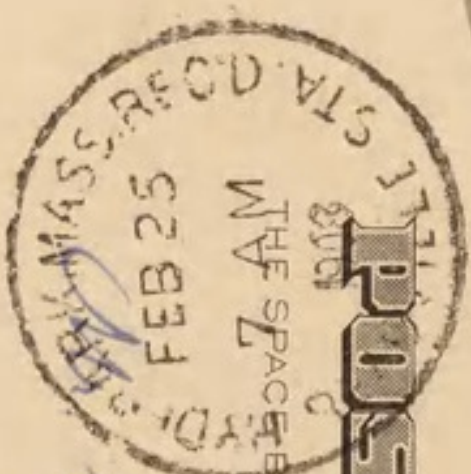
