Dear Walter: Thank you ever so much Sending the Mole, it is Brewer's Mole- Parascalops breweri - named for Dr. T.M. Brever by Barid. It is currons that the type locality is 8 and to be mortha's Vineyand, but it does not occur there, and the real place of origin of the type is unknown. It looks superficially like the common Mole. Scalopus aquations, but has very different teeth, and a more northern distribution, from southern Canada to morthern mass, & south along the alleghences to Pa. It seems partial to sandy spavelly soils. I am glad to have the specimen. The Stanwood made is the only other Mole in n. It., o is semiagnatic, honig in meadows espectally and often in blade mudey bogs. I doubt if you could trap either species in an ordinary trap. Specially made mole traps do it well, however, set so that they are spring by the mole agreeping through the jaws as it passes along The burrow. I hank you for your thought fulness. We are all fairly well and have spent the Spring at dexeigton, and now plan to go to Bothbay Harbon (or near there) for the summer, I opening our house at Cambridge in Deptember. I hope you are very well and having a ford summer. I saw Dr. Tyler yesterday. He tells me Dr. Faxon has become much interested in ferms, especially over the forms of aspidium in the Breusten warbler Owarup.
