

Middlebury May 31. 1915

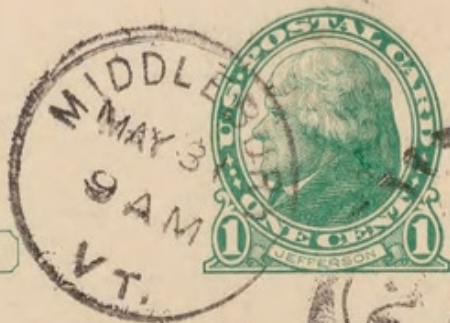
