Underwoods herbaria a specimen labelled O. vulgatum collected by Turner in Unalaska, in 1878(Eaton specimen) 1879 Gray Herb. which I do not think is that species. It belongs to the O/reticulatum group according to Prantl, and comes nearest according to description and his figures to O. pedunculosum of Japan, of which I have not seen any specimens, that are authentic. I have made tracings from the fronds in the herbaria, and should be much obliged if y u wold ake some for me from yours at the lass. Hort Soc. I enclose paper and a tracing that you may see what I mean. have a species which appears to be new which I am de cribing as O. arenarium, and of which Mr. Pollard will send you a specimen as soon as his labels are printed.
