ria Oregon* & *Scopulina* were
among those found. The latter
you can retain; also, ¹⁰ *lv.*
Oregana if desired, but if
not, I would be glad of a
specimen which has passed
under your critical eye.

I found no *Asp. septent.*
and of *Cheilanthes*, only *Fendleri*
& *Canupensis*. I have plenty

of *E. Fendleri*, though not of
the best, as the season was
advanced. can send you
some if desired. *Pellaea*
Woodh. (one specimen) is
all the only ^{other species of} fern collected
except those you have seen.

My stay was short, and
very brief at any one spot -
and ferns, in my course, were
very much less frequently
met than at the East.

I thank you for the kind-
ness of your offer, and wish I
had a lot to send you; but
I believe the apertures already
given removes my only doubts.
On entering our my ferns

should I find doubtful
characters I will gladly
avail myself of your kind
help
