As I have secured but very few forms this season, I must think that I shall have to go down to the coast-region or far to the south for more - but not this year. Hope to have homeward in two weeks -

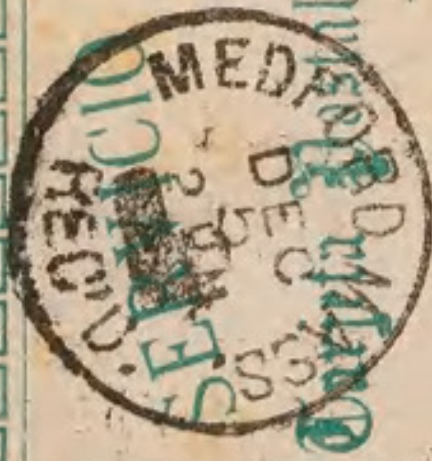
