You might it is in the library (Mass. Hort.)

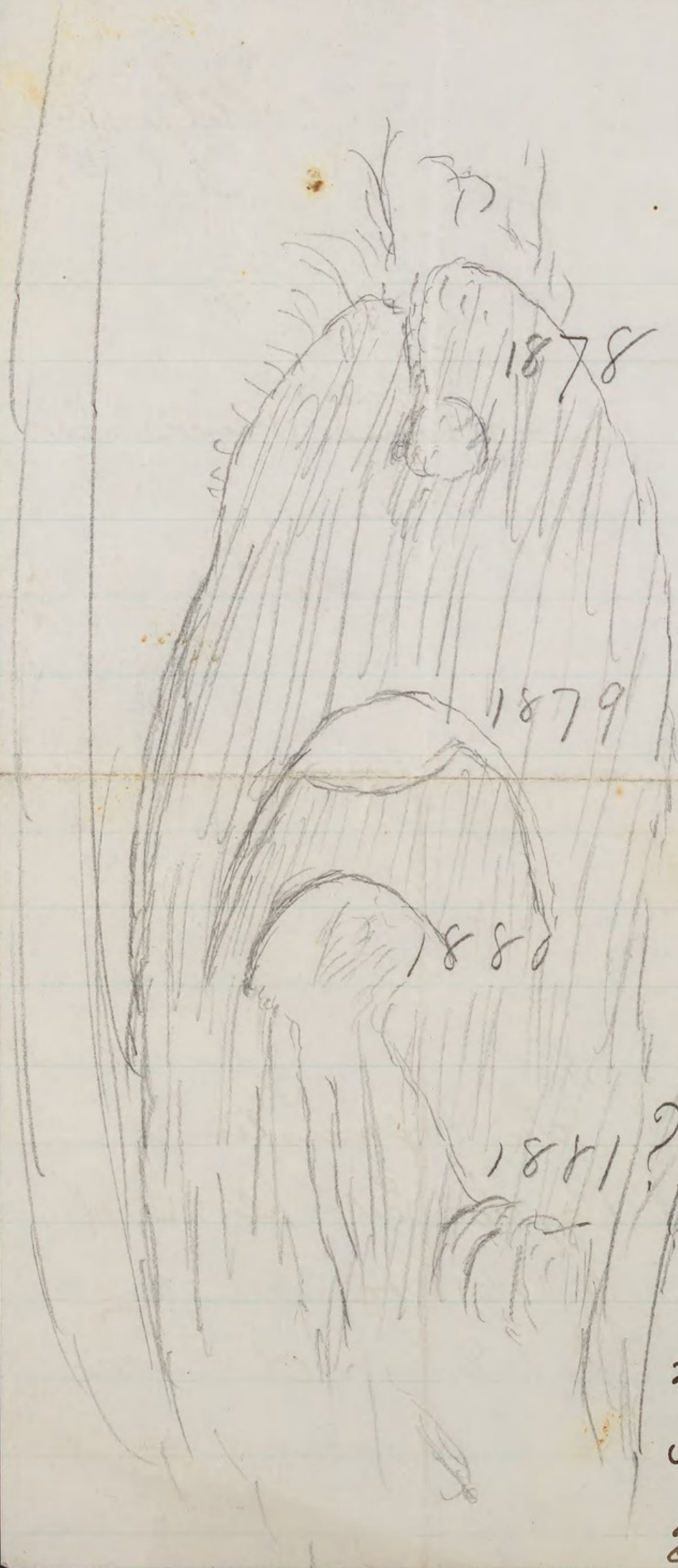
