7 **Spodiopogon Duclouxii** A. Camus, nov. sp. 8

Perennis. Rhizoma crassum. Culmi subrobusti, erecti, 1,20-1,40 m. alti, striati, simplices, 8-nodi, glaberrimi. Laminæ e basi valde angustata linearilanceolatæ, 15-25 cm. longæ, 1,2-1,8 cm. latae, longe acuminatæ, cuspidatæ, planæ, supra scaberulæ, subtus pilis adpersæ, margine scabræ; costa media crassa; petiolus 5-15 mm. longus. Vaginæ striatæ, glaberrimæ. Ligula membranacea, truncata, 1,5 mm. longa, pilis stipata. Panicula 10-12 cm. longa; rami verticillati, subpatuli, indivisi, glabri, tenues, filiformes, apice incrassati, 1,5-5 cm. longi. Racemi 2-4-articulati, 1-1,2 cm. longi; articuli pedicellique spiculæ medium superantes, marginibus parce ciliati. Spiculæ binæ, primaria pedicellata a pedicello soluta, secundaria sessilis cum racheos articulo accumbente decidens. Spiculæ sessiles 5 mm. longæ, lanceolatæ, acutæ, callo pilis spiculæ 5-6-plo brevioribus parce barbato; gluma I^{ma} 4,5-4,8 mm. longa, lanceolata, acuminata, 6-nervis, parce pilosa; II^{da} 5 mm. longa, lanceolata, apice bidentula, margine ciliata, 5-nervis; III^a 4 mm. longa, hyalina, apice bidentula, inter denticulos aristulata, extus pilosa; aristula 1 mm. longa, scaberula; IV^a 4 mm. longa, hyalina, lanceolata, bifida, laciniis acuminatis; arista subperfecta, gracilis, 7-8 mm. longa; palea hyalina, subbidentula. Stigmata e spiculæ apice exserta. Spiculæ pedicellatæ: gluma I^{ma} multinervis.
