San Ramon 80 miles nearly due West of Durango City - Tepehuanes at end of Rail Road from Durango City - Tabar 9 miles S. W. of Tepehuanes - Otenapa 65 miles N. W. of Durango City - Tejamen 121 Kilometers from Durango City North 24 degrees West.

These localities have not been before botanically visited. So hope there are many new and rare plants. As the cold of winter is coming on. Shall commence to morrow to put this years collection into sets that I may go to a warm place for the winter. And before sending out the sets of 1906 would like to send to the purchasers of last years plants a list of their names and in order to do so, could you send us a copy of your determinations of 1905 plants this will greatly accommodate me and enable me to escape the cold. And may I have
