County employees have a wonderful opportunity to enroll in adult evening courses sponsored by the Los Angeles Metropolitan College of Business, Los Angeles Trade Technical Junior College, or East Los Angeles Junior College. These courses range from those dealing with supervision to accounting and trade courses. The only cost is \$2.50 for registration. This entitles you to take as many courses as you wish. The courses are given at the Hall of Administration, 222 North Grand Avenue, in Los Angeles. They usually begin at 5:30PM and end at 8:30PM -- being conducted once a week. Examples of courses available to you are: Basic Supervision; Civil Service Rules and Procedures; Report Writing; Business Correspondence; Business English; Accounting; various trades courses; Psychology; Rates Processing; and Police Science. Two of these courses, Report Writing and Business Communications, are taught by our Senior Administrative Assistant, Richard Watson. You can receive college credit for these courses. They are designed to increase your vocational proficiency. Course bulletins should be posted near you in the near future. Contact Dr. Louis Martin or Richard Watson if you have questions. Registration is during the first two weeks of February.
