



This is the fourth annual "Day at the Races" sponsored by the California Arboretum Foundation, Inc. through the courtesy of the Santa Anita Racing Association. Again this year the proceeds will be channeled into the Peacock Pavilion Fund. The Pavilion will house Foundation activities and provide eating facilities for Arboretum visitors.

Tables on the Luncheon Terrace have been reserved for us in the best locations. Luncheon may be purchased, or refreshments obtained throughout the afternoon. The Terrace, which opens at noon, has its own elevator, bar and pari-mutuel windows.

Foundation members may buy tickets at our cost of \$2.65. This means, of course, that only one person of a membership has this privilege. In organization memberships, one person representing the group may buy a ticket at cost. The regular charge for these tickets is \$5.50 and all persons who buy tickets at this price are allowed a tax deduction of \$2.85 on each ticket because of the non-profit status of the Foundation. Holders of "Day at the Races" tickets are to use the Clubhouse entrance gate at Huntington and Colorado Place. There is a parking charge of 25 cents per car.

Reservation slips must be returned by February 25th. Tables will be assigned in the order in which reservations are received.
