On September 8 & 9, The Arboretum and the California Gourd Society will celebrate the many ways that groups of people (ethno) use plants (botanical) to make our lives a little better. And, the magical gourd will be "the plant" of the weekend celebration. Programs will center on the historical, cultural and contemporary use of hard shelled gourds.

"Gourd Fair LA" will bring together artists, gourd growers, gourd musicians, crafters and the horticulture community. **Weekend highlights include:** 

...John Sturgeon, President of the American Gourd Society, will be bringing with him from Indiana **new gourd seed varieties** for shapes that are rarely seen in California. Seeds will be available for purchase.

...Pam Elam Geisel, director of the Master Gardener Program at the University of California Extension, will share home **gardening tips** and discuss gourds as a specialized small farm crop.

...Jim Bauml, The Arboretum's senior biologist, will present the **history of gourds** throughout the world.

... Leigh Adams will conduct outdoor seminars each day, sharing tips from her many years as an educator specializing in the **use of gourds to teach Spanish**. Gourds are great to integrate into art, music and science lessons. Lesson plan strategies will be shared.
