"GARDENING UNDER MEDITERRANEAN SKIES"

This fall the third annual "Gardening Under Mediterranean Skies" symposium, jointly produced with the Strybing Arboretum and *Pacific Horticulture Magazine*, will be held at The Arboretum for the second time.

The five Mediterranean regions of the world have mild temperate climates that include both a rainy season in winter and drought conditions in summer. California, the countries surrounding the Mediterranean Sea, the Western Cape of South Africa, Chile's central coast and southern and southwestern Australia, all make up the areas categorized as Mediterranean zones and share many similarities in botanical specimens and horticultural practices.
