## 27. AUSTROTURNIX, gen. nov.

Differs from *Turnix* Bonnaterre in having a much thicker, deeper bill.

Type, *Turnix castanotus* Gould.

## 69. TERRAPHAPS, gen. nov.

Differs from *Geophaps* in having the bare space round the eye much more extensive ; deeper and heavier bill, and stouter feet.

Type, *Geophaps smithii* Jardine and Selby.

## 271. MYOLA, gen. nov.

Differs from *Notophoyx* in having the bill a little more than half the length of the tarsus.

Type, *Notophoyx pacifica* (Latham).

## 273. TONOPHOYX, gen. nov.

Differs from *Notophoyx* in having a very long crest.

Type, *Notophoyx flavirostris* (Sharpe).

## 282. TOBURIDES, gen. nov.

Differs from *Butorides* in having a longer bill in proportion to its tarsus.

Type, *Butorides rogersi* Mathews.
