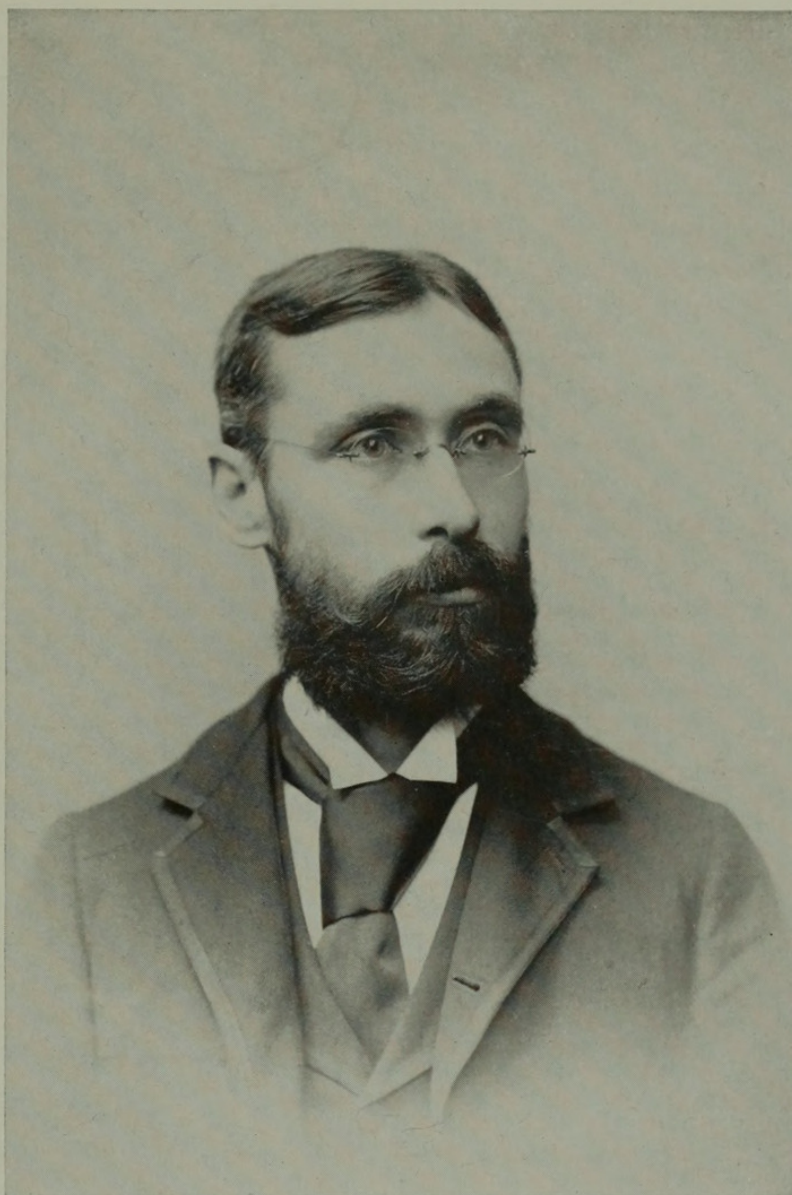

December 7, 1862–October 26, 1957

**I**T is our pleasure to dedicate this third volume of *Johnsonia* to Dr. Pilsbry. Though he is perhaps most famous for his work on land mollusks, particularly those of North America, and his revision of the helices, he published many papers on marine mollusks. In fact, his publications in the latter field, though a small part of his total studies, probably exceed those which many workers produce in the course of a lifetime. His main studies on marine mollusks were those done in the first series of the *Manual of*
