In the last Bot. Contribution, which you so kindly sent me, I observe that you doubt th. if the corolla of Krantzia leucophaea is ever yellow. So far as ^{to the} ^{plant} we collect as on the Mojave side of the San. Bds Mts. is concerned, it certainly is yellow, the more recently opened central flowers light yellow, & the older outer ones darker. At a distance it might almost be taken for Dryas asperum.

We are having a long, dry spell & vegetation is backward. I hope the California trip helps.
