Dear Sir.

I send you by Harraden's Express line a bundle containing a set of Composite for Hooker containing 118 specimens, and 601 specimens of various orders for Mr. Casey, wh. I hope will prove satisfactory to him. At any rate they have cost me a good deal of money, much time, & considerable risk in the procuring, for wh. what I let for Hennens is not like to remunerate me. The expense of conveying things over land, the whole distance of the continent, is a very different affair to the making of what is elsewhere. If a pint of New England rum ^{wh.} costs 12 cents, has to be charged 3 dollars. Some ^{in the mountains} sea may be found of the value of other things drafted on horseback over double such a route.

I am long that your letter came to hand after my paper was printed off as there remain no opportunity of making the acknowledgement you required.

As to Crothysyne. I had made the remark that it appear to be nearly that genus, & ^{had} exactly the habit but no place on the receptacle. I see the same thing is also present in Eulichis. If there is really such a plant with false bracts, (as they are particularly described by Eulichis & D. C.) much as one plant resembles it is still probably not the same.

As some things in my manuscript have not been published, will you oblige me by sending my manuscripts with the Academy's collection when you send them

As to Lindley's plant Ditropidium incanum (of wh. nothing can be told by the miserable painted figure in Bot Mag.) I must say, that I have seen nothing else in California wh. at all approaches it. The Crothysyne, wh. is every where a common plant there; if not the same it is another of those curious isomorphes wh. seem to obtain in that quarter.
