Dear Sir

I send in this mail a package of specimens for name. I wrote you about three or four mos. ago, and you kindly agreed to give me the names of what I might send. I intended to send them before leaving the College last Oct. Took them with me to Houston. While there I made some arrangement with Dr. Joar (Asst. Commissioner for the Exposition) about having some grasses & sedges on exhibit. I sold him 220 specimens; making with those he furnished about 300. He has had them framed. So there will be a pretty fair exhibit at the Exposition, of Texas grasses & sedges.

As to the specimens I send, A, B, C, D, E & G, are from Hardin Co. up in the longleaf pine belt. I gathered B & D in Apr. G in May, and A, C & E in June. F is common about Beaumont in the swampy lands; in bloom in April & May. H in bloom about here through
