Dear Dr Gray

I was detained at Sandy-Hill a week longer than I expected. illness or death of a younger sister did not reach here till yesterday. It is getting so late that I must shorten up visits and if I come to you at all it must be for only a day or so early next week.

Under these circumstances it is not likely that Mr P will accompany me and I shall leave Cambridge direct for the west, leaving Mr P to finish out here visit here.

In regard to European sets of Utah plants I have no written mem with me but remember the three sets sent you to dispose of were as follows over

de Candolle V-let \$ 50.00
Boisner \$ 30.00
Maxomony (less) \$ 20.00
Total \$ 100.00

If you have received only from
the two former. The amount should
be \$ 80.00. It can wait till I
come.

I shall have flowering specimen
of Shepherdia rotundifolia from Siberia
on my return to Davenport. He
writes he has sent "100 specimens"
he has probably sent sorts or
cuttings to Sargent before issue
cls. of Peraphyllum.

I have not seen the list
in my Naturalist. They have sent
me extras to Davenport. When I
get back I will return you 20 or
more of the complete paper for European
Society to hear of the J. application
