Dear Mr Gray

I was detained at
Sandy-Hill. a week longer than I
expected. illness & death of a younger
sister. Did not reach here till yesterday.
It is getting so late that I must
shorten up visits. and if I come to
you at all it must be for only
a day or so early next week.
Under these circumstances it is
not likely that Mr P will accompany
me. and I shall leave Cambridge
direct for the west, leaving Mr P
to finish out here visit here.

In regard to European sets of Utah
plants I have no written men-
with me but remember. The three
sets sent you to dispose of were as
follows over

De Candolle V^l set \$50.00
Boissier \$30.00
Maxon (less) \$20.00
Total \$100.00

If you have received only from
the two former. the amount should
be \$80.00. It can wait till I
come.

I shall have flowering specimen
of Shepherdia rotundifolia from Siler
on my return to Davenport. He
writes he has sent "100 specimens"
he has probably sent roots &
cuttings to Sargent before now
also of Peraphyllum.

I have not seen The list
in My Naturalist. They have sent
me extra to Davenport. when I
get back I will return you 25 or
more of the complete paper for Enson
song to hear of the f. office then
Mr P. Desmet regards
