Thanks for the news. Silcia Veatchii was never
published, as I concluded you were right in
referring it to S. Californica, which presents
specimen confirming the me synonym I spared.
I am in no haste to settle the Herbarium
question.

A word about Arctostaphylos. What would you
say to change the name of A. Laufradii to
A. diversifolia? though Laufrad was really the
collector, he is hardly deserving of special
recognition, and the latter name being the
variety in my published account is quite
characteristic & appropriate but I only make
the suggestion, leaving the decision with you.
Again I do not see how you can fit A. numularia
into any other proposed section B. characterized so
remarkably by its thin fragile spicars, entire absence
of discocarp, and the 4. separably deciduous nutlets.

help to sober him. I have yet to write him
a report of our interview.
