Thanks for your kind letter of 16<sup>th</sup> but we have cooler weather, I begin to recuperate though coughing fearfully yet - and (stubborn as age is getting, you know) I want to have those ~~cosies~~ off my hands before I go exploring, - if I can! We will see, whether renewed spells of hot weather will break me down - then I must go - but with this cough I can not travel at all!

I return you kindly Bentham's letter. You have seen what he says about small flowers of conifers.

I had another one from him soon after yours in which he handsomely acknowledged his errors in Amenth. etc & you have saved me from one of those blunders, arising from overlooking what has been published, which I have been claiming so much in others"

Well, our young couple were married day before yesterday (and the railroad trip there with heat dust I smoke

Made me a good deal worse for  
the time, but that is past now.  
They have written from Croimati today  
and will reach Cambridge in good time  
(- about 2 weeks?)

No, I hope that the California Co's
