stigmatum residuis basilaribus vel in fructibus lobatis lateralibus vel centralibus,
epicarpio coriaceo, mesocarpio gremoso, endocarpio tenuiter vitreo crustaceo.
Semen liberum subglobosum erectum, hilo basilari, raphe adscendente utrinque
ramis 2-3 manifestis curvatis, albumine aequabili; embryo basilaris.
