Schimper sent us a new species under the name of *Dicranum pallidum* a specimen which Tullivant & myself recognized as our *D. spurius* which is very slightly different from the European form. That is No 85 of the Musci. For the other, the synonymy should be *D. condensatum*, Hedw as in No 86 of the Musci, erasing var. *condensatum* or *levis*, var. *condensatum* (as of the authors) without reference. which is only indicated upon labels in Tullivant's herbarium? or at least in my own and as you say can not be mentioned.
