My dear Dr. Watson:--

The proof with its accompanying MS. came duly to hand. When I send out galley proof to authors I correct it at the same time by MS. and return to printer, after which it is made up. By the time that I receive corrected proofs from authors the Gazette is paged, and I incorporate their corrections on the paged revise. I know that this is not an ideal way to manage, but it is adopted to save time.

If you will make out bill on your paper in the form enclosed and mail it to me I will see that the money for the Musci Exotici is forthcoming.
