Dear Professor,

By this mail I send you a package of plants collected by me in this County last year. I should have sent the plants before, if I had not felt too unwell to attend to the matter.

I have about come to the conclusion not to send any plants to Mr. George Watson, nor to Cambridge during your absence. I have sent Mr. Watson a considerable number of new and rare plants, and have never received any recognition from him. He has been very generous in acknowledging the labors of the Parish Brothers of San Bernardo, and has done them the justice they deserve. It is not necessary

that I should submit to this treatment, nor a credit to him, and I do not propose to do so unless his policy towards me is changed.

I have a small collection

of grasses & rushes from this County, collected in 1881, which I can send to some one willing to name them.

I hope that you are in good health.
