Dr. Woolworth, our Sec'y, will
have put up for Prof. Seligman
dollar or package containing
the Regents' Reports & the
Cabinet Reports (so far as

June 1854. We have, it seems,
no correspondence with the Société
de Physique et de Médecine. The
packages can, however, be sent
through the Smithsonian Institution.
But when, if sent to it, it will
be despatched, we do not know.
To collect the reports ~~with~~ for all
we care of them, will require
some days. And you will
please write to me at Buffalo,
N. Y. which will be better, to
S. B. Washburn, ^{S. B.} Sec'y of the
Regents, Albany. Whether you
