These remaining plates will be printed and delivered with those already finished, we expect, by

the middle of next week
- 5th prox.

Regarding the statement
in letter referred to ^{by you} dated 9th inst
in which "78 plates" were mentioned
that was an error in counting
the single and double plates.

The plates are No from 1 to 75
with a prefixed View plate -
making 76 in all.

prove satisfactory
