American plants originally destined for London which you looked over and put for Liverpool instead probably you then put the Wrightian one in question on to the wrong heap

I shall write from Doulosne to tell the precise time when we return through London as I hope I may come down to New York an hour to see the Hookers & yourselves

I send a box with Hookers. Yours & Torrey's Encasoneae - it will leave this on Saturday
