Dear Dr. Payson,

I have no doubt now that Fenzl's 1646 is the *Echinolæva polystachya* W.W.K. The glumes on my specimens vary from being as hispid as yours to having simple papillæ with no hispid elongation - and this on the same plant.

I find that my specimen of true *Echinolæva* is *E. hirta*, Desv. which may be the same as *E. scabra* W.W.K. as Bentz & Winkl. seem to intimate ("Specis 1" &c.)

I am very much obliged for your sketches and other information which have helped me very much.
