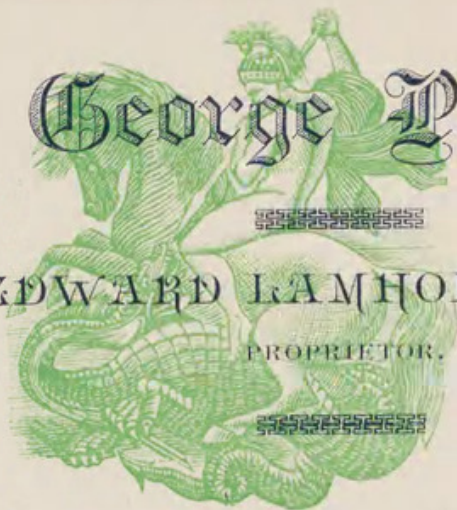

## Analysis of Croton ?

found on the sandy shore of the  
Platte River in Schuyler Colfax  
County, Nebraska—

Erect, 2-3<sup>o</sup> feet high, dichoto-  
mously branched, leaves petioled,  
linear-lanceolate; <sup>repand</sup> stellate pubescent

Flower dioecious. — Staminate  
flowers with 5 parted calyx, <sup>no petals</sup> stamens  
11) eleven, base of calyx with 5 glands.  
Pistillate calyx 5 parted, base with  
a saucer-shaped gland, no petals,  
ovary stellate-tomentose + dehiscent —  
pod 3 lobed, separating into 3 carpels —  
Seed carunculate. — Styles dichotomously  
parted —
