I have now examined the proliferation of *Cyphomeria*, which I found in the Central Park - N York - but it does not offer any valuable clue. The buds gradually loose the terminal ^(The cap!) base & ^{and} become leaves and one of them bears a branchlet in the axil. That is all!

Your former Gardener was here on his way to Arkansas; I will give him some valuable information.
