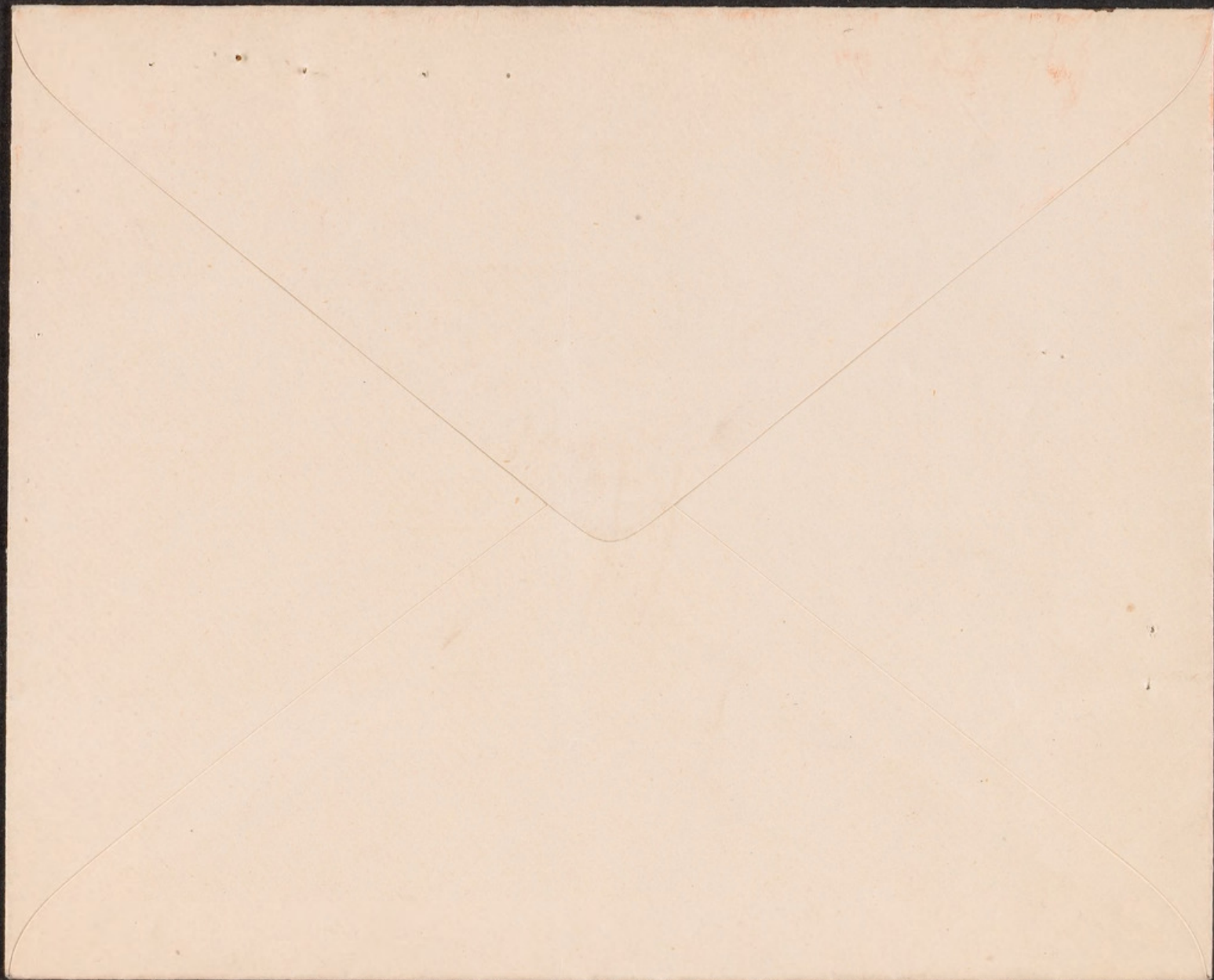


The bunch of seaweed that looks like hair,
