You need not return any of the
specimens ^{unless they are of no use to you.}. Have kept duplicates
corresponding with those sent, and
lettered alike so I can identify
^{properly named.} specimens. If your knowledge may
be drawn upon for the names,
you will confer a great favor
upon me.

Enclose a lettered
list and have made my guess
at each, except two or three. The
line is blank ^{for your use} opposite each
letter. This gives room for your
name, that is, the proper name
of each. Except the last

which without doubt is an animal. Under my microscope I could see indications of a circulation going on in what I had at first thought was a plant.

Had been in N. C. for my vacation, ^{this summer} and found some fresh water specimens. Appear to be like those you named for me last summer from Cheat River W. Va.

Enclosed is postage for reply. You can return either this blank list when names are written or make ~~a~~ ^{another} other if more convenient.

Hope you had a pleasant summer and no domestic troubles. As the cool weather is come I may look for specimens in the harbor. If in any way I can serve you let me have the pleasure of so doing. Yours truly
