Hel.⁹ (*P. glycyrrhiza* ^{Eaton}) a Californian
variety with the pinnæ finely toothed
and narrowed very gradually to an
acute point

You will notice that the larger
of the two fronds answers somewhat
the description and is quite different
in shape from the small one which
I take from another plant -
